8- HOUR EPA – RRP LEAD-SAFE WORK PRACTICES INITIAL COURSE

Penalties for performing work without being EPA – RRP LEAD-SAFE CERTIFIED can lead to penalties of up to \$37,500 per violation, per day.

Since **April 22, 2010**, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has required firms performing work that disturbs lead-based paint in residential homes (i.e., apartment complexes, condominiums, townhomes, loft apartments), child care facilities, and schools built before 1978 be EPA certified, ensure necessary EPA certified renovators are on each job, ensure all workers affected are trained in specific work practices to prevent lead contamination, all work is performed according to EPA work practices, pre-renovation education required for residents, and ensure record keeping requirements are met. Additionally, all persons are required to be licensed/certified by the appropriate State agency where the work is occurring or by EPA. There is also a requirement for refresher training for any person who becomes licensed/certified every **5-years**. Penalties for performing work without being EPA certified can lead to penalties of up to **\$37,500 per violation, per day**. The Builders' Association is an EPA accredited training provider. This course is approved for purposes of certification under Section 402 of TSCA for the respective discipline.
