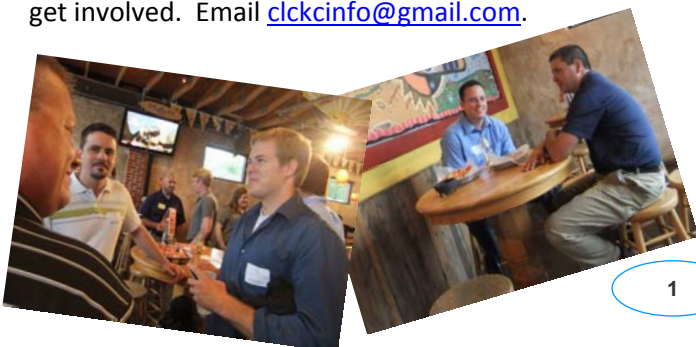
Impressive Turnout Helps Makes July Happy Hour a Networking Success!

1st Annual CLC Texas Hold 'em Poker Tournament

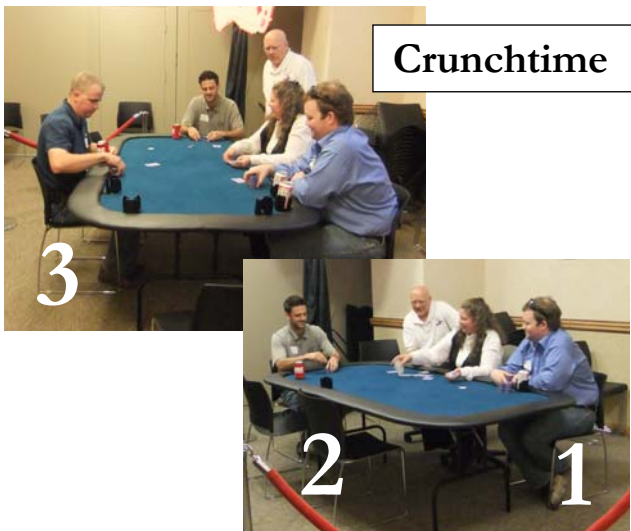

Kansas City Chapter-CLC Shares Programs with 2010 AGC Student Event

April 8th and 9th were the dates of the first two-day student event hosted by the Kansas City Chapter-AGC and The Builders' Association. The Kansas City Chapter-CLC joined the Missouri State University AGC Student Chapter for a project tour of the Kansas City Structural Steel facility and a dinner presentation on the new Wizards Stadium project.

Tab White explained how Kansas City Structural Steel attained enough LEED® rating system points to become the first Gold-certified manufacturing facility in the Midwest. In addition to detailing the design selections and construction processes, Tab reviewed specific elements of their facility. These unique items included fabric ducts for conditioned air distribution, a composting septic system that is independent of the city sewer, a propane-fueled metro delivery truck, and a temperature-controlled fabrication shop with heated floors. Of specific interest to both students and project managers was the advantage this environment provides for the coating and painting stage of the fabrication process. A tour of the entire facility followed with groups led by Tab and Mike Bennett.

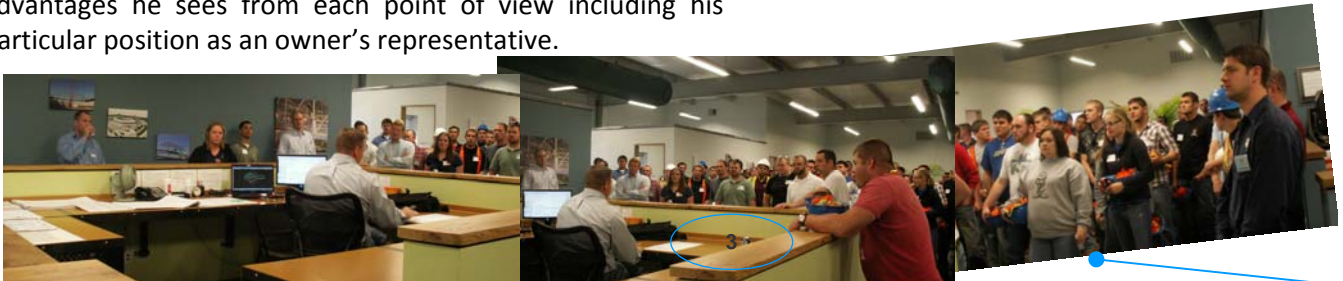
On Thursday evening, the CLC joined the same students for a dinner presentation at Dave & Buster's in Kansas City, Kansas. The focus of the presentation was the use of a building information model (BIM) to facilitate design, construction, and ownership of the new Wizards Stadium. Mike McKeen with Turner Construction led the presentation and utilized a model from Populous to illustrate the information provided in a BIM and how it prepares the entire team to anticipate conflicts and improve project execution. Rory O'Connor with OnGoal addressed several aspects of using BIM and the advantages he sees from each point of view including his particular position as an owner's representative.
